The \$5.3 billion Philadelphia Public Employees Retirement System will issue an RFP for a small-cap value manager, said CIO ChrisMcDonough. The search is to possibly replace Boston Partners for performance reasons.

The \$348 million Brockton (Mass.) Contributory Retirement System is planning to make a \$20 million maiden allocation to hedge funds of funds because the board is not happy with domestic equity returns.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol Retirement System has issued an RFP for hedge fund of funds managers. The hire is an attempt to diversify its investment portfolio and reach its 8% annual returns.
